Dear Friends,

I write to share information and instructions for our Outdoor Worship Services on August 2, 16, and 30, 2020 at 10:20 am. August 9 and 23 will be virtual only.

*On Sunday, August 2 please bring your own communion if you would like to receive.*

1. You may park in the parking lot and sit in your car with the windows down or sit in a lawn chair in front of your car.
2. You may bring lawn chairs and/or a blanket and sit in the cemetery making sure you are 6 feet away from other people. If you choose this option, we ask that you park somewhere other than the church parking lot.
3. Masks must be worn. We will be praying in unison, so there could be a risk of transmission without a mask, even if we are 6 feet apart.
4. The bathrooms in Fellowship Hall will be open.
  - a. Only 2 people will be allowed in the bathroom at one time.
  - b. Each stall will have sanitizer available for use. I recommend that you wipe down the toilet seat before and after use.
  - c. Soap and hand sanitizer will be by each sink.
  - d. There will be additional cleaning supplies in each bathroom.
5. The portable microphone and speaker will be used so you should be able to hear.
6. Please bring a printed copy of the Order of Worship with you or your smart phone or tablet to access the Order of Worship. There will be a limited number of copies available.
7. Please make your contribution to our church online or mail your check to the church office.
8. The service will still be streamed in our regular fashion.

By having these services outdoors, there is less risk to contract coronavirus than if these services were held indoors. However, this is still a risk of contracting the virus anytime people gather together. If you do not feel well, have a fever, or if you are uncomfortable about being in a gathering of people, please stay home.

In the case of inclement weather, a final decision will be made by 9 am on Sunday morning. In case we have to move to virtual only, we will let you know by posting on FaceBook, posting on the church website, and putting it on the voicemail message on the church phone.
